What it does:

Allows you to add certain attributes about a person that you wish to track. Attributes can be pulled by a report, plus they can be configured to show on different screens in Quest.

Adding the table entry

Notes:

- **Code** – Choose a code. It can be 1-4 characters.
- **Short description** – The short description can be up to 15 characters
- **Long description** – The long description is what the users see, it can be up to 50 characters long.
- **Special (Y/N)** – If Y, then this attribute will be highlighted on various screens when displayed, such as the Case Detail screen shown below.
- **At risk (Y/N)** – IF Y, then this attribute identifies the person as being 'at risk' on several screens.

- **Add only (Y/N)** – If Y, then this attribute can only be added and can't be removed without *ALL authority.
- **Value table** - If specified, the generic validation table that contains the valid values associated with this attribute that will have to be selected. (See [GVT | Tables](#))
- **Grouping** – If specific, all attributes with a given grouping will be grouped together on the edit screen. All groupings can be defined in the AttributeGroups table, if you want descriptions displayed for each grouping.
