

# Case Attribute Type

## What it does:

---

Allows you to add options for gathering statistics about the case. Similar attributes can be grouped together, the attribute can be highlighted on certain screens, and it can be programmed that this is an add only. Once added it can't be removed.

Code(attribute type) can be 1-4 characters.  
Special(Y/N) - If Y, then this attribute will be highlighted on various screens when displayed.  
Add only(Y/N) - If Y, then this attribute can only be added and can't be removed without \*ALL authority.  
Show Pers(Y/N) - If Y, then this attribute will be displayed on the person detail screen (with the case).  
Value table - If specified, the generic validation table that contains the valid values associated with this attribute that will have to be selected.  
Grouping - If specified, all attributes with a given grouping will be grouped together on the edit screen. All groupings can be defined in the AttributeGroups table, if you want descriptions displayed for each grouping.

- **Add Only (Y/N)** – If Y, then this attribute can only be added and can't be removed without \*ALL authority.
- **Show Pers(Y/N)** - If Y, then this attribute will be displayed on the person detail screen (with the case).

- **Value table** - If specified, the generic validation table that contains the valid values associated with this attribute that will have to be selected. (See [GVT | Tables](#))
- **Grouping** – If specified, all attributes with a given grouping will be grouped together on the edit screen. All groupings can be defined in the AttributeGroups table if you want descriptions displayed for each grouping.
