What it does:

Allows you to define the different attribute types for incidents. Statistics can be pulled for attributes. In Indiana this can be used to determine the location the incident occurred for JDAI reports.

Incident Attribute Type

Entry details

Code(attribute type) can be 1-4 characters.
Special(Y/N) - If Y, then this attribute will be highlighted on various screens when displayed.
Grouping - If specified, all attributes with a given grouping will be grouped together on the edit screen. All groupings can be defined in the AttributeGroups table, if you want descriptions displayed for each grouping.

Notes:

- **Code** – Choose a code. It can be 1-4 characters.
- **Short description** – The short description can be up to 15 characters
- **Long description** – The long description is what the users see, it can be up to 50 characters long.
- **Special (Y/N)** – If Y, then this attribute will be highlighted on various screens when displayed.
- **Grouping** – If specified, all attributes with the same grouping will be grouped together on the edit screen.
