

Requirement attribute type

What it does:

Allows you to define the different attributes you can assign to requirements. Attributes can be used for statistics. For example, if you have a child on system generated random drug testing and anyone with that requirement with an attribute of blue gets randomly selected every 3 weeks for a drug test.

Adding the table entry

Menu | Tables | Generic Validation Tables |

Requirement Attribute Type Entry details

Code(attribute type) can be 1-4 characters.

Special(Y/N) - If Y, then this attribute will be highlighted on various screens when displayed.

Requirement Type - If specified, this will only be displayed for requirements of the type (or type/code) specified.

Grouping - If specified, all attributes with a given grouping will be grouped together on the edit screen. All groupings can be defined in the AttributeGroups table, if you want descriptions displayed for each grouping.

Short description:* Blue

Long description:* Blue

Special (Y/N): n

Require Type: CC/RE

Grouping: DTCC

Active:* Yes No

Notes:

- **Code** – Choose a code. It can be 1-4 characters.
- **Short description** – The short description can be up to 15 characters
- **Long description** – The long description is what the users see, it can be up to 50 characters long.
- **Special (Y/N)** – If Y, then this attribute will be highlighted on various screens when displayed.
- **Requirement Type** – If specified, this will only be displayed for requirements of the type/code specified.
- **Grouping** – If specified, all attributes with the same grouping will be together on the edit screen.
