

# Type of cause number to generate

## What it does:

Provides the options for the different ways you can automatically generate cause numbers based on court and case type.

## Adding the table entry

In general, this entry is used for Indiana's GenerateCause functionality.

The short description should be:

CaseType - for each court, if each case type should have it's own sequence number

CaseTypeCrtType - for each court type (superior, circuit), if each case type should have it's own sequence number

CaseTypeNoCourt - regardless of court, if each case type should have it's own sequence number

Shared - for each court, if there should be one unique sequence number shared between the various case types

SharedNoCourt - regardless of court, if there should be one unique sequence number shared between the various case types

CaseType – Courts and Case Types do not share numbers. Each court and each case type starts at 1 and continues sequentially. C01-18-JD-1, D01-18-JD-1, D02-18-JD-1, D03-18-JD-1.

CaseTypeCrtType – Same Court Type shares numbers per case type. It looks at the first character of the assigned/home court's official court, so Circuit and Superior are separated, but within each court each case type is numbered sequentially. If Superior has a D01, D02, D03, they share the numbers for each case type. D01-18-JD-1, D02-18-JD-2, D03-18-JD, 3, etc.

CaseTypeNoCourt – All Courts share numbers per case type. Just looks at the case type and shares the numbers across all the courts. So Circuit and Superior would share the sequential numbers for each case type. C01-18-JP-1, D01-18-JP-2, C01-18-JP-3, etc.

Shared – Separated by Court Case Types share the same number. D01-18-JP-1, D01-18-RS-2, D01-18-JD-3. C01-18-JP-1, C01-18-RS-2, C01-18-JD-3.

SharedNoCourt - All Courts share numbers and all Case Types share numbered sequentially. C01-18-JP-1, D02-18-JD-2, D01-18-JP-3, C01-18-RS-4, D01-18-JS-5, etc.
