

# Requirement component type

## What it does:

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Allows you to define the different types of requirement components, such as sentenced, executed, jail credit, suspended, probation, etc.

## Adding the table entry

### Requirement Component Type Entry details

Requirement Type - If specified, this will only be displayed for requirements of the type (or type/code) specified.  
Life/Death(y/n) - If 'y', then this component type can have life/death terms. Otherwise, a life/death term can't be specified.

Notes:

- **Code** – Choose a code. It can be 1-4 characters.
- **Short description** – The short description can be up to 15 characters
- **Long description** – The long description is what the users see, it can be up to 50 characters long.
- **Require Type** – If specified, this will only be displayed for requirements of the type/code specified.
- **Life/Death (Y/N)** – If y, then this entry signifies life or death.
