

# Custody status

## What it does:

---

Allows you to add options for the different types of custody. The custody status can make the relative with that custody appear on the docket. There are template functions that will allow the type of custody to be removed from lists, such as a custody status of “parental rights terminated.”

## Adding the table entry

Short description:*	Legal

- **Code** – Choose a code. It can be 1-4 characters.
- **Short description** – The short description can be up to 15 characters
- **Long description** – The long description is what the users see, it can be up to 50 characters long.
- **On docket (Y/N)** – If Y, then the relative with this type of custody will show on the court docket. For example, you may not want all relative type “Aunt” to show on the docket unless that Aunt has legal custody, then you do.
