Where the data comes from:

The report is looking for the number of cases that are open. It breaks it down by the Assigned/Home Court.

The over 21 is not included in the total. So, for C01, you have 8,262 that are 21 and under and you have 9,050 over 21. With that said, if a case has someone over and under, it will be in both totals for cases.

If you want to identify "families" you can set up an "other ID" and call it family and give everyone in that family the same ID number. You can then count how many families are in each court. Mothers can have multiple family ID numbers if her children have different fathers.
