What it does:

Allows you to control the options available for the status of a person's employment. It also determines if that option means "employed" or not.

Adding the table entry

- **Code** – Choose a code. It can be 1-4 characters.
- **Short description** – The short description can be up to 15 characters
- **Long description** – The long description is what the users see, it can be up to 50 characters long.
- **Employed (Y/N)** – Y or N, does this employment status code indicate active employment?

Many reports will look at the employed Y/N to report that a person is or is not employed.
