

# Number of days to wait before approving a form

## What it does:

---

If you want orders to wait a number of days before being sent to the Judge's approval list, you can specify the number of days to wait in this table. In Baltimore, if a hearing is held by a magistrate, the attorneys have 8 days to object to the findings and orders. That is why there is the ability to object to a document. If this is set, then the document won't show up on the screen for the judge to approve until the exception period expires. That is also why we have the ability to set documents for immediate approval. Some orders don't need the objection period.
