

FF ADDRESS

What it does:

Prints the address with or without phone numbers in various formats. This formats the address of the first identity tied to the form.

Used in template:

Template

Remember: This function is used to format the address of the **first identity tied to the form**.

What the user sees:

The user does not see anything, this is automatic.

FF ADDRESS/00 – Formats address of first id - stack, w/phone

This function is used to format the address of the first identity tied to the form. Only the first active address will be included as will any phone numbers. If you want a protected address to actually be output, the variable must end with a '+'. An entry will look something like:

Street
City, State Zip Country

FF ADDRESS/01 – Formats address of first id - string, no phone

This function is used to format the address of the first identity tied to the form. Only the first active address will be included, but not phone numbers. If you want a protected address to actually be output, the variable must end with a '+'. An entry will look something like:

Street, City, State Zip Country

FF ADDRESS/02 – Display identity detail screen

This function is used to display the identity detail screen, which can then be used to update information about the person.

FF ADDRESS/03 – Formats address of first id - stack, no phone

This function is used to format the address of the first identity tied to the form. Only the first active address will be included but not phone numbers. If you want a protected address to actually be output, the variable must end with a '+'. An entry will look something like:

Street
City, State Zip Country

FF ADDRESS/04 – Formats address of first id - stack, w/type/phone

This function is used to format the address of the first identity tied to the form. All active addresses will be included as will any phone numbers. If you want a protected address to actually be output, the variable must end with a '+'. An entry will look something like:
