

FF AUTOPRT

What it does:

This function is used to send a message to the user identified in the FF AutoPrt Defaults table entry to print the document. It can be sent as a quest message, email message, or fax if your system is capable of sending a fax through Quest.

Make sure you use the @d/ with this option or the user will get notified before the document is finished. If you want the user notified before they finish the document, use @v/ instead.

What the user sees:

The user will see the question asking them if they wish to notify anyone of this document, but they don't see anything with regards to this function.

Output:

There is no output other than a Quest Message or an Email message that the document has been created.

When you click on the name of the document you are taken to the Document Detail screen for that document. From there you can view, assign, whatever.

FF AUTOPRT/00 – Send message to print the document

The userID of the person who should receive a message to print a document when this function is used. The function FF AutoPrt/00 accesses this value.

Instead of sending to the userid in the short description, you may also specify one of the entries below. In that case, let the long description be the name of the person sending the email/fax.

fax=123-456-7890

email.n=abc@xyz
email.1=Angelyn.McCurrie@dcs.in.gov

userID.n=johndoe
