What it does:

Puts the case numbers or the petition numbers in a document.

Variables

What the user sees:

The user doesn't see anything, this is automatic.

FF CAUSE/00 – Cause numbers - string

This function strings together all cause numbers for cases tied to the document. If the variable ends with a '+', it will include the history of all cause numbers for each case.

FF CAUSE/01 – Cause numbers - stack

This function stacks all cause numbers for cases tied to the document. If the variable ends with a '+', it will include the history of all cause numbers for each case.

FF CAUSE/02 – Petition numbers - string

This function strings together all petition numbers tied to the document. The petitions must first have been selected using one of the FF PETNS functions.

FF CAUSE/03 – Petition numbers - stack

This function stacks all petition numbers tied to the document. The petitions must first have been selected using one of the FF PETNS functions.
