FF CURDATE/04 – Current date - nth Day of Month, Year

FF CURDATE/05 – Current date - MM/DD/YY HH:MM A

FF CURDATE/06 – Current date - nth Day of Month, Year at HH:MM a

FF CURDATE/07 – Current date - Month

FF CURDATE/08 – Current date - Year

FF CURDATE/09 – Current date - Month Year

FF CURDATE/10 – Current date - MM/YY
