Formats the entered date as described in the long description. If the variable name ends with a '-', then the date can't be in the future. If it ends with a '+', then the date can't be in the past.

FF DATE/01 – Date - Month DD, Year

FF DATE/02 – Date - MM/DD/YY

FF DATE/03 – Date - Day, the nth Day of Month, Year

FF DATE/04 – Date - nth Day of Month, Year

FF DATE/10 – Date - Day, Month DD, Year at h:mm:ss a

FF DATE/11 – Date - Month DD, Year at h:mm:ss a

FF DATE/12 – Date - MM/DD/YY at h:mm:ss a

FF DATE/13 – Date -Day, the nth Day of Month, Year at h:mm:ss a

FF DATE/14 – Date - nth Day of Month, Year at h:mm:ss a

FF DATE/20 – Date - Month

FF DATE/21 – Date - Year

FF DATE/22 – Date - Month Year
