What it does:

Puts a date into a document but instead of an empty date field, it defaults to the current date. This comes in various format.



What the user sees:

The current date is already in the box. They can change the date or update to accept it.



Output:

FF DATEDEF/00: Thursday, October 25, 2018
FF DATEDEF/01: October 25, 2018
FF DATEDEF/02: 10/25/18
FF DATEDEF/03: Thursday, the 25th day of October, 2018
FF DATEDEF/04: 25th day of October, 2018
```

FF DATEDEF/00 – Default date - Day, Month DD, Year

Formats the entered date as described in the long description. Screen initially defaults to the current date

FF DATEDEF/01 – Default date - Month DD, Year

FF DATEDEF/02 – Default date - MM/DD/YY

FF DATEDEF/03 – Default date - Day, the nth Day of Month, Year

FF DATEDEF/04 – Default date - nth Day of Month, Year
