

FF FEE

What it does:

This function lets you use the default fee tables to set up fee amounts for specific fees then put that amount into a document.

Used in template:

Template

```
@v/selcase/
```

```
You are ordered to pay $@v/fee/ for a docket fee.

Whatever the amount in the short description of the default table that matches the fee code used in the template is printed in the document.

What the user sees:

The user doesn't see anything, this is automatic.

Output:

FF FEE/06 –Formats monthly IA probation fee from defaults
