What it does:

This function is used to format identifying information for the first person tied to the document, such as age, dob, sex, race, birthplace, height, weight, hair, eyes, ethnicity, citizenship, language, marital status, religion, physical identifiers.

FF IDBLK/00 – Formats id block of first id - w/physical idents

This function is used to format the id block of the first identity tied to the form. NOTE: if the variable name ends with a '-', it will only show the year of dob and the last 4 of ssn. It will be formatted as follows:

FF IDBLK/01 – Formats id block of first id - no physical idents

FF IDBLK/02 – Formats physical idents of first id

This function is used to format the physical identifiers of the first identity tied to the form. It will be formatted as follows:

FF IDBLK/03 – Formats id block of first id - w/physical idents

FF IDBLK/10 – Formats ethnicity of first id

This function is used to format the ethnicity of the first identity tied to the form.

FF IDBLK/11 – Formats citizenship of first id

This function is used to format the citizenship of the first identity tied to the form.

FF IDBLK/12 – Formats language of first id

This function is used to format the language of the first identity tied to the form.

FF IDBLK/13 – Formats marital status of first id

This function is used to format the marital status of the first identity tied to the form.

FF IDBLK/14 – Formats religion of first id

This function is used to format the religion of the first identity tied to the form.
