What the user sees:

Output:

FF IMMADR/00 – Set document for needing immediate approval

FF IMMADR/01 – Set document for needing approval

FF IMMADR/02 – Set document as approved (automatic approval)

FF IMMADR/03 – Set document as needing to be filed

FF IMMADR/04 – Set document to no approval needed
