FF OPER/00 – Formats name of the user logged on

This function is used to format the name of the user currently logged onto the application.

FF OPER/10 – Formats name of the user logged on; no over

Just like FF OPER/00. This mode will NOT overwrite an entry that has already been made.

FF OPER/01 – Formats agency of the user logged on

This function is used to format the agency of the user currently logged onto the application.

FF OPER/11 – Formats agency of the user logged on; no over

Just like FF OPER/01. This mode will NOT overwrite an entry that has already been made.

FF OPER/02 – Formats person type of the user logged on

This function is used to format the person type of the user currently logged onto the application.

FF OPER/12 – Formats person type of the user logged on; no over

Just like FF OPER/02. This mode will NOT overwrite an entry that has already been made.

FF OPER/03 – Formats initials of the user logged on

This function is used to format the initials of the user currently logged onto the application.

FF OPER/13 – Formats initials of the user logged on; no over

Just like FF OPER/03. This mode will NOT overwrite an entry that has already been made.

FF OPER/04 – Formats name/address of the user logged on

This function is used to format the name and address (with contact numbers) of the user currently logged onto the application. If the variable ends with a '+', it will include all addresses for the person.

FF OPER/14 – Formats name/addr of the user logged on; no over

Just like FF OPER/04. This mode will NOT overwrite an entry that has already been made.

FF OPER/05 – Formats name/person type of the user logged on

This function is used to format the name and person type of the user currently logged onto the application.

FF OPER/06 – Formats name/type/phone of the user logged on

This function is used to format the name, person type and phone number of the user currently logged onto the application. The phone number displayed is based on the name of the variable defined.

FF OPER/07 – Formats phone of the user logged on

This function is used to format the phone number of the user currently logged onto the application. The phone number displayed is based on the name of the variable defined.

FF OPER/15 – Formats phone of the user logged on; no over

Just like FF OPER/07. This mode will NOT overwrite an entry that has already been made.

FF OPER/08 – Formats name/credentials of the user logged on

This function is used to format the name and credentials of the user currently logged onto the application. The credentials displayed come from person notes and are based on the entry type matching anything after the '-' of the variable name (or the variable name itself if no '-'). For example, a variable name of 'user-cred', where you have an entry type of 'cred'.

FF OPER/18 – Formats name/credentials of the user logged on; no over

Just like FF OPER/08. This mode will NOT overwrite an entry that has already been made.

FF OPER/09 – Formats employer address/phone or logo of the user

This function is used to format either the logo url or the address and phone number of the employer agency, division, or unit for the user currently logged into the application. If the variable ends with a '+', it will include all addresses for the person. If the variable ends with a '#', it will string only the first address. The default is to use unit, but the variable name determines which to use (name = agency, division, unit). If the variables ends with a '@', it will output the url of the logo, which is specified in each agency/division/unit table entry. In the notes of the table entry, specify something like: logo=/equest/images/mylogo.png

FF OPER/19 – Formats employer address/phone or logo of the user; no over

Just like FF OPER/09. This mode will NOT overwrite an entry that has already been made.
