Where the data comes from:

The report looks for incidents that occurred during the date range. There must be a felony or misdemeanor incident statute for it to be included. Race and ethnicity come from person detail screen.

1. Arrests
 - a. The report will look for incidents as defined in the report settings: incident type that means arrest.
2. Referrals
 - a. Will report on every type of incident found including arrests.
3. Diversion:
 - a. Will look for a case status as defined in the report settings: case status that means 'diversion'
4. Detention:
 - a. Looking at the cases to see if there was a secure facility stay associated with the case.
5. Recommendations:
 - a. We look at recommendations on the case name that matches the incident name and provide what the recommendation was.
6. Petition/Charges filed:
 - a. We look at the filed statutes for that case to determine if the charges were filed.
7. Delinquent findings:
 - a. Reflects those cases that had filed statutes dispositions of guilty
8. Probation:
 - a. Looks for probation requirements as defined in the report settings: requirement type that means 'probation'.
9. Secure Confinement to different secure facilities.
 - a. Looks for requirements that mean a secure correctional facility as defined in the report settings: requirement type/codes for secure correctional facilities
10. Waived:
 - a. Looks for a case status that means waived to adult court as defined in the report settings: case status that means 'waived'
