

## Rule GAW090 – Update Case Status

Apply when: Documents database file  
 Subtask: F  
 Standard GAWDBObject subtasks:  
 'C' - on object creation  
 'R' - before referential integrity  
 'i/I' - before/after insert  
 'u/U' - before/after update  
 'd/D' - before/after delete  
 Sequence: 15 (Controls the order in which rules will be applied for a given subtask)  
 Java class:\*

This is meant to act as a trigger to update the case status when a document is file stamped (by default) or other time, if specified.

It can be used any time on a documents object ('F' after file stamp, 'a' - upon completion, 'A' - upon approval, etc.)

This function purposely uses objects, so all other rules are executed when updates occur. The documents that cause updates are determined in the 'RULEPARMS' entry of the 'DEFAULTS' table.

Valid properties are:

UpdateCaseStatus.template=case status (default - processes if file stamp 'F')

UpdateCaseStatus.mode.template=case status (can specify any mode)

If mode specified, it will only be executed when called from that mode.

Template should be the uppercase template name.

Case status should be the case status you want set. It can be case status or case status/status reason
