

# Rule GAW105 – Tennessee Generate Cause

## Rules

### CaseNames database file

---

Apply when: CaseNames database file

Subtask: I

Standard GAWDBObject subtasks:

'C' - on object creation

'R' - before referential integrity

'i'/'I' - before/after insert

'u'/'U' - before/after update

'd'/'D' - before/after delete

Sequence: 1 (Controls the order in which rules will be applied for a given subtask)

Java class: \*

Generates the cause number for a filed case if a number isn't currently assigned.

This only works with a sendingObject that has a getCase() method or is a Cases object. It is really intended for use from the CaseNames object though.

In TN, the NLU type format for cause numbers is case#yyyycc and

the cause number is yyyyccnnnnnn where:

yyyy is the year of filing,

cc is the case type, and

nnnnnn is the sequence number.

If the number is going to be greater than 999999, we'll just let it grow as needed.
