

Rule GAW108 – Send Message for Requirements

Apply when: Requirements database file

Subtask: P

Standard GAWDBObject subtasks:

'C' - on object creation

'R' - before referential integrity

'i'/'I' - before/after insert

'u'/'U' - before/after update

'd'/'D' - before/after delete

Sequence: 7 (Controls the order in which rules will be applied for a given subtask)

Java class:*

Sends a Quest message to all active case assignments (who are Quest users) for the names tied to the underlying requirement letting them know about this particular item. It also allows you to specify additional people to receive notification.

It can be called at any time from either the Requirements object, or any object that implements the Requirement interface. NOTE: Use a 'P' on the Requirements database object if you want to send notification of payments for requirements.

It will automatically include all requirement types/codes unless you specify only specific ones to include. It is also possible to skip specific requirement types or types/codes. These are determined by the settings in the 'RULEPARMS' entry of the 'DEFAULTS' table.

Valid properties are:

SendMessageForRequirements.include.n=<type> or <type>/<code>

SendMessageForRequirements.skip.n=<type> or <type>/<code>

SendMessageForRequirements.notify.n=<userid>

where <type> is requirement type

<code> is requirement code

<userid> is valid Quest userID

n must start at 1 and increment by 1 for each entry specified.
