

Secures a record by checking for open case.

This is meant to protect a descendant of the IDENTITY database object.

It must be used on the 'On Creation' of the database object.

Most groups only have access to the record if the person has an OPEN case of a type the user is authorized to.

The groups with access regardless of case type authority are determined by the settings in the 'RULEPARMS' entry of the 'DEFAULTS' table.

Valid properties are:

SecureByOpenCase.n=<group id> group id is a user group that has unrestricted access n must start at 1 and increment by 1 for each entry specified.

Rule Setup:

Apply the rule to any database you don't want people to see if there are no open cases.
