

Identifier type for OtherIDs

What it does:

Adding the table entry Allows you to add options for the other numbers that may be associated with a person, such as Drivers License number or DOC number or the number used for this person in another computer system.

- **Code** – Choose a code. It can be 1-4 characters.
- **Short description** – The short description can be up to 15 characters
- **Long description** – The long description is what the users see, it can be up to 50 characters long.
- **On docket (Y/N)** – If Y, and if the Other ID is associated with the scheduled case, it will appear on the court docket.
- **Case (Y/N)** – If Y, then a case must be tied to this number type. If N, then a case can NOT be tied to it. If it is blank, then it doesn't matter whether a case is tied to it or not. For example, a driver's license number is the same regardless of what types of cases they have so it is a N. However, if you were adding a child support case and wanted to link the ISETS# or TCSES# number to it, it would be case specific because a person may have multiple child support cases for that type of ID would be a Y.
- **Copy (Y/N)** – If Y, then when updating on the Edit Other ID screen, other people with the same ID will automatically be selected so this ID is added to their name as well.
