

Location code for facilities

What it does:

Allows you to specify the different locations within a facility or the different facilities used by your county. These locations can be considered “secure” or “non-secure.” You can specify the capacity of each location.

Adding the table entry

Location Code For Facilities Entry details

Secure is used to designate secure ('Y') locations. Any value but 'Y' will be considered non-secure

Capacity is the number of persons a unit will hold.

Separation indicates whether the system will check for separation violations for this unit. The system will check for violations unless this value is 'N'.

Location group places this detention location into a named group. This group name can then be used when defining entries in the classification and/or privilege level table to limit classifications and/or privilege level entries to the group name.

Bed table is the table name of the valid beds for this location code. The default table ASSIGNEDBEDS will be used if not specified.
