## Report Description:

This report will allow you to pull statistics on many areas of your jurisdiction.

## Running the Report:

Enter the desired from dates for the first date range. Enter a desired range in the second group if you would like to compare June 2017 to June 2018 for example. If you leave the second group of dates empty, the report will provide the Year To Date totals. You can pull the report for all case types to get total numbers or specify only a specific case type.

The report produces a PDF document with many sections. For simplicity sake I ran this report on JD case types only limiting the report to only those with a Role of DEF.

1. Referring agencies – When the case is created a Referring agency is required, this reports how many cases were referred during the time period and lists the Referring agency for each case.
