

Plea

What it does:

Allows you to define the different types of pleas a person can enter. You can program if this type of plea counts as guilty or not.

Adding the table entry

**Plea
Entry details**

Code(statute disposition) can be 1-4 characters.
Guilty (Y/N) - If Y, then this plea counts as 'guilty'; otherwise, counts as 'not guilty'.
Case Type - Limit to specific case type (leave blank for all).

Code: GA
Short description:* Admit
Long description:* Admit
Guilty (Y/N): Y
Case Type:
Active:* Yes No

Notes:

- **Code** – Choose a code. It can be 1-4 characters.
- **Short description** – The short description can be up to 15 characters
- **Long description** – The long description is what the users see, it can be up to 50 characters long.
- **Guilty** – If Y, then this plea counts as “guilty”; otherwise, counts as “not guilty.”
- **Case Type** – Limit to specific case type.
