

# Supervision level

## What it does:

Allows you to define the different levels of supervision in your county, such as High, Medium, Low. This also allows you to program how many days between contacts, if those contacts must be “in person” contacts, and how often a person is on this level before changing levels.

## Adding the table entry

### Supervision Level Entry details

Code(supervision level) can be 1-4 characters.  
Color - Can be any valid HTML color code setting.  
Days - How often between contacts.  
Contact person - When determining days between contacts, limit to this contact person (if specified).  
In Person (Y/N) - When determining days between contacts, if Y, limit to in person contacts only.  
Level Days - How often between changing levels.

Notes:

- **Code** – Choose a code. It can be 1-4 characters.
- **Short description** – The short description can be up to 15 characters
- **Long description** – The long description is what the users see, it can be up to 50 characters long.
