Change the case status from "Case Filed" to "Transferred In".


Click on the existing case status

Add a Case Number


To add a new case number for your court, click the Add link at the end of the line.




You can click the **Generate** button at the bottom of the screen to get the next available case/docket number, or you can manually type in a docket number.
